REQUESTED ACTION:

The Fire Rescue Department requests approval to extend its current contract with Advanced Data Processing, Inc., a subsidiary of InterMedix Corporation for an additional extension period from June 2, 2019 through September 30, 2019, to facilitate the implementation time required for the newly selected vendor, McKesson, to begin providing patient billing services.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION and BACKGROUND:

In order to provide sufficient time to conduct a competitive RFP process for EMS billing services, Fire Rescue received BOCC approval on February 26, 2019, to extend the current ADPI/Intermedix billing services agreement for a period of ninety (90) days (through June 2, 2019). This request was necessary to facilitate the execution of the RFP process. The RFP selection process has been completed and the newly selected vendor, McKesson, requires per their proposal an implementation period of ninety (90) days to begin providing patient billing services.

In order to provide uninterrupted patient billing services, the Department is requesting an additional extension period, through September 30, 2019, to the ADPI/Intermedix billing services agreement to allow sufficient time for the newly selected vendor to assume billing services.

**AMENDMENT EXTENDING EXISTING CONTRACT
FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES BILLING AND RELATED PROFESSIONAL SERVICES**

THIS CONTRACT AMENDMENT is made and entered into this 21st day of May, 2019, by and between the following Parties: Advanced Data Processing, Inc. a Subsidiary of InterMedix Corporation, and the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Parties previously entered into a Contract to perform patient billing services and related professional services for Fire Rescue's Emergency Medical Services (EMS) within Brevard County on March 3, 2014, as amended on November 1, 2016, and then extended its term to June 2, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to extend the Contract term for an additional ninety (90) days to provide sufficient time for the newly selected patient billing services vendor to assume billing services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties mutually agree as follows:

1. The term of the previous Contract between the Parties is amended to provide a second extension from June 2, 2019 to a new expiration date of September 30, 2019.
2. With exception of the term extension, all the terms and conditions of the Contract dated March 3, 2014, as amended on November 1, 2016, remain in full force and effect with no modification.
3. Each Party warrants that the person signing on its behalf has been fully authorized by all required action to sign on behalf of and to bind that Party to this Contract Amendment.
