Permission to "Piggyback" the Lee County Contract # B170265ANB for Full-Depth Reclamation Services

FISCAL IMPACT:

Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Public Works funds are budgeted in 1180/262040. Solid Waste Reserve funds are budgeted in 4010/940110.

DEPT/OFFICE:

REQUESTED ACTION:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners grant permission to "piggyback" the Lee County Contract # B170265ANB with Asphalt Paving Systems, Inc. (APS) to provide road reconstruction services including Full-Depth Reclamation on various types of County maintained roads. It is also requested that the Board authorize the use of Reserve Funds from Solid Waste to be utilized for the cost-share on Adamson Road Reconstruction. It is further requested the Board approve any Budget Change Requests associated with these actions.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION and BACKGROUND:

Public Works has identified roadways suitable for Full-Depth Reclamation (FDR), an inplace recycling method for reconstruction. The implementation of this method on various types of County roads (Local, Collector, Arterial), where applicable, provides cost savings of material transport and time savings compared to traditional methods of reconstruction.

Currently, Brevard County does not have a term contract that provides FDR services. Board Procurement Policy, BCC-25, requires Board approval of any contracts exceeding \$100,000 if not previously authorized. Public Works is requesting permission to "piggyback" the Lee County contract #B170265ANB with Asphalt Paving Systems, Inc. to provide FDR services.

The Lee County contract meets the same service requirements needed by Brevard County for FDR. "Piggybacking" the Lee County contract will allow the use of FDR estimated at \$1,063,000.00 on various County roads.

Adamson Road in Cocoa is the only access to the Brevard County Central Disposal Facility. Heavy trucking activities have contributed to the deterioration of the roadway which now requires reconstruction and is estimated to cost \$1,206,000.00. Solid Waste has agreed to utilize Reserve funds and contribute \$606,000.00 to the Adamson Road reconstruction project.
