A RESOLUTION ON BEHALF OF THE BREVARD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RECOGNIZING EDEN BENTLEY FOR HER OUTSTANDING SERVICE AS THE COUNTY ATTORNEY FOR BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, Ms. Eden Bentley has been providing sound counsel to the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners in various capacities since 1986; and

WHEREAS, upon her elevation to County Attorney in 2018, Ms. Bentley became the first female County Attorney selected in Brevard County's history; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Bentley was admitted to the Florida Bar on October 27, 1983 after graduating from University of Florida's Levin College of Law; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Bentley is Board Certified in the area of Real Estate by the Florida Bar and Rated AV by Martindale-Hubbell, Preeminent, peer rated for the highest level of professional excellence; and

WHEREAS, her contributions to the County are, quite literally, immeasurable due to the sheer breadth of her career, having worked to protect the interests of the County in matters including, but certainly not limited to, land use, countless road projects, utilities projects, environmental law, business transactions, emergency powers, labor law, taxation, and ethics; and

WHEAREAS, Ms. Bentley is associated with the Florida Supreme Court's landmark decision in Brevard County v. Snyder, in which the Court turned the world of land use and zoning law in Florida on its head by converting zoning decisions into quasi-judicial proceedings, to the exclusion of legislative determinations by City Councils and County Commissions; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Bentley's reputation for providing level-headed, detail-oriented advice is well-deserved; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Bentley has litigated many critical cases on behalf of the County, always doing so with the utmost skill and professionalism; and

WHEREAS, she has spent many hours at Board meetings, keeping a straight face while witnessing such things as presentations involving live tortoises, visits from Santa Claus, hawks, giant dogs, Commissioners' outrageous outfits such as a pirate, a farmer, and a mime, as well as a certain Housing and Human Services Director's loud yet tasteful suits, Ms. United States, bins full of allegedly carcinogenic garbage, yoga performances, and claims that the North Koreans would spy on citizens through sonar; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Bentley is now ending her career having helped guide the County through several stages of an unprecedented public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, she accomplished all of these things and much more in a fiscally responsible way, while earning the respect of her colleagues; and

WHEREAS, Eden Bentley's expert advice will be sorely missed in the years to come by all members of the Board of County Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners hereby recognizes and thanks Eden Bentley for her outstanding legal advice and wise counsel on behalf of Brevard County, and congratulates her on her retirement.
