Summary Explanation and Background:

On April 4, 2020 ECT and the County entered into a Professional Engineering Services Contract. Contracted services include: civil, design, surveying, inspection, permitting, construction, hydrologic, environmental, transportation, marine, structural, and other related services. In January 2022, the County was notified that the Senior Project Manager, Chris Fagerstrom, identified in the contract as the person to receive Notices related to this contract, was no longer employed by the consultant. ECT requested that the Notice section in the contract be revised, to add Mr. Robert Johnson, P.E. Water Resources Group Manager, as the responsible team member, to receive notices as described in Section 41 - Notice. Mr. Johnson was part of the originally approved ECT Team and his hourly rates are in line with the previous senior project manager.

FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT BETWEEN BREVARD COUNTY AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONSULTING AND TECHNOLOGY, INC.

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT is made and entered into this ____ day of ____, 2022, by and between Environmental Consulting and Technology, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor") and the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (hereinafter referred to as the "County"). The Contractor and County are sometimes herein collectively referred to as the "Parties."

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Contractor and County previously entered into a Professional Engineering Services Contract on April 4, 2020, for continuing professional engineering services for the Brevard County Natural Resources Management Department for some or all aspects of engineering services such as civil, design, surveying, inspection, permitting, construction, hydrologic, environmental, transportation, marine, structural, and other related services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to amend the Contract as specifically provided herein.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein set forth, the Parties agree and covenant as follows:

Section 41, Notice is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 41 – NOTICE

- 2. All other terms and conditions of the Contract not inconsistent with the provisions of this First Amendment shall remain in full force and effect. In the event of a conflict between the Contract and this First Amendment, the terms of the First Amendment shall prevail.
- 3. This First Amendment shall become effective immediately upon execution by both parties.
