#### REQUESTED ACTION:

Approval is requested for the attached recommendations from the Brevard County Community Cultural Grant Review Panel to award grants to 30 nonprofit cultural organizations or cultural programs within the county

#### SUMMARY EXPLANATION and BACKGROUND:

The Brevard County Community Cultural Grant program was established by the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners in 1987 and, on their behalf, Brevard Cultural Alliance (BCA) manages and administers the Cultural Grant Program through an approved competitive and rigorous process.

Following are the recommendations of a grant review panel. The Board is asked to approve \$130,000 in grant awards for 30 nonprofit cultural organizations or cultural programs for FY19.

#### Cultural Grant Program timeline:

- The document which details the application process and provides program guidelines [attached]. The County Attorney reviewed and County Commission approved the guidelines in 2015. Dates were updated for the FY19 grant cycle.
- A comprehensive grant workshop for potential applicant organizations was conducted on August 24, 2018
- Application deadline for the program was September 21, 2018
- Grant review panel convened on November 5, 2018 to score applications and recommend funding, per the attached funding iteration formula, provided by RSM US, who staffed the meeting to validate and tabulate panel scores.

Approval of the attached recommendations from the Brevard County Community Cultural Grant Review Panel will provide funding to 30 cultural organizations or programs for the October 2018 – September 2019 funding cycle. The grantees are required to provide Quarterly reports throughout the grant period. Grant funds are released on a reimbursement basis.

The Panel, comprised of five members, included: Chair Andrea Farmer, Kennedy Space Center Visitor Complex; Julie Braga, Residence Inn by Marriot Melbourne; Cindy Johnson, Brevard Public Schools; Cordell Rolle, Liberty IT Solutions; and Andrew Weintraub.

The participating organizations are required to provide quarterly reports which clearly illustrate how much the participants have spent in the county. For the last full year of this program quarterly reports illustrated that the \$130,000 acted as a catalyst for participants to spend \$8,873,193. This in-county expenditure was on line items such as materials and supplies for use in productions or exhibits and event, marketing & print costs, equipment purchases, insurance costs, office supplies, contract services and rent or mortgages, etc.

The average grant for the 2018-2019 program is around \$4,300 and it will only contribute a small element of "general program support" rather than funding to mount a full production or year round program.

All grant payments to grantees are on a reimbursement basis.

In order to be reimbursed, up to the level of their grant award, grantee organizations are required to submit records of expenditures, which must be backed up by invoices and check numbers, or in the case of credit card payments account statements showing payments made receipts. These are reviewed to ensure that only qualifying expenditures are accepted - and only to the amount allowed. These verified documents are then passed to the county for double verification and sign off - after which a check request for reimbursement is made.

#### **PURPOSE**

The mission of the Brevard County Community Cultural Grants Program is to cultivate excellence, accessibility and diversity in arts and culture for all people in Brevard County, Florida. Funded by the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners and managed by Brevard Cultural Alliance (BCA), this program funds private nonprofit arts and cultural organizations through General Program Support or Specific Projects; and funds cultural projects by private nonprofit non-arts or non-cultural organizations through Specific Projects only.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

Every applicant must meet the requirements and follow the procedures in this eligibility section.

- Be a nonprofit, tax-exempt, Florida Corporation as a result of being:
  - a. Incorporated or authorized as a nonprofit Florida corporation in good standing, pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes as of application deadline date; and,
  - b. Headquartered in Brevard County as of application deadline; and,
  - c. Designated as a tax-exempt organization as defined in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, prior to application deadline.
  - d. Prior year's total operating budget was \$5,000 or more.

#### **FUNDING AND GRANT AMOUNT REQUESTS**

- Large: Organizations whose prior year total general operating budget was \$400,000 or more may request up to \$30,000
- Mid-size: Organizations whose prior year total general operating budget was more than \$100,000 and less than \$400,000 may request up to \$20,000
- Small: Organizations whose prior year total general operating budget was \$100,000 or less may request up to \$7,500

#### MINIMUM SCORING REQUIREMENT

An average of at least 80.0 quality points out of a possible 100 points must be earned to be eligible for FY 2018-19 grant funding. There is no guarantee of annual funding to any applicant.

**APPLICATIONS DUE:** completed application forms, required documents and optional support materials must be submitted electronically by 11:59pm by **Friday, September 21, 2018.**All applications will be completed and submitted using online application software.

#### **SUPPORT MATERIALS:**

Support materials can provide panelists with a more complete picture of the proposal and are optional but strongly encouraged. Support materials uploaded after the application deadline will not be provided to the panel.

#### PANEL MEETING INFORMATION

The grant panel will consist of members of the Brevard Cultural Alliance Board of Directors and community representatives. The grant panel will convene in a public meeting to evaluate applications. Applicants are not required to attend but are encouraged to be present to answer any questions panelists may have about their applications. Public comments will be accepted. At the conclusion of the meeting the panel will make funding recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners. The Board of County Commissioners will make final funding determinations at a separate public meeting where public comment will be accepted.

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF GRANT AWARDS

- 1. An applicant organization may not apply under more than one organizational name or category.
- **2.** An applicant organization shall be deemed ineligible for funding if the grant application is incomplete.
- **3.** The Cultural Grant Program reserves the right to allow for the clarification of questionable entries and for the correction of obvious mistakes on submitted documents.
- 4. The grant amount requested must not exceed 50% of the total program or project costs.
- 5. In-kind contributions used as matching funds may not exceed 25% of the total project budget.
- 6. Grant funds are released on a reimbursement basis.
- **7.** Organizations not meeting the administrative requirements of previous grants shall be determined to be ineligible for funding for one year.
- **8.** Organizations receiving funding from other Brevard County government sources, with the exception of capital facilities projects, community based organizations (CBO) or Tourist Development Council (TDC), may not also receive funding through General Program or Specific Project support from the County Community Cultural Grants Program.
- **9.** All grant-funded activities must fall within the Brevard County fiscal year, October 1, 2018 September 30, 2019. The project start and end dates are not intended to be performance or event dates, but the entire period during which grant related expenses may be spent and revenues received.
- **10.** Applicant organizations must maintain files of documentation of volunteer time and signed inkind receipts stating actual value of contributions. These records are subject to audit.
- 11. In accordance with Brevard County's Art in Public Places policies, all projects, programs and/or exhibits funded by the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners must be suitable for viewing by people of all ages.
- 12. The grant recipient shall keep books, records, and accounts of all activities related to the grant in compliance with appropriate generally accepted accounting procedures. All documents, papers, books, records and accounts made or received by the grantee in conjunction with the grant shall be open to inspection during regular business hours and shall be retained by the grantee for a period of three years after termination of the grant period, unless such records are exempt from section 24(a) of Article I of the State Constitution and section 119.07(1) Florida Statutes.
- **13.** No grant application materials will be accepted unless submitted before or on September 21, 2018.
- **14.** In lieu of the previously required Final Report form, all grantees must complete and submit their required quarterly reports, as well as 3-5 electronic images depicting programmatic activity, and electronic documentation of credit line and logo usage at the conclusion of the grant period.
- 15. Credit Line Usage and Logo Requirement: Any publicity or publications related to programs or projects funded by Brevard County Community Cultural Grants listing or recognizing funders or sponsors shall include Brevard County and BCA logos and/or the following statement: Sponsored in part by the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners through Brevard Cultural Alliance.

#### **Allowables and Non-Allowables:**

#### Allowable Costs:

- expenditures within the grant period specified on the grant application and/or the period specified by the Brevard County Budget Department; and,
- they are solely for the purposes of the grant and can be easily identified as such.

#### Non-Allowable Costs:

- expenditures before or after the grant period;
- lobbying or attempting to influence federal, state, or local legislation;
- capital improvements, including but not limited to new construction, renovation, and installation or replacement of fixtures in the permanent facility of the organization;
- bad debts, contingencies, fines and penalties, interest, other financial costs and costs of litigation;
- benefits and projects planned primarily for fund raising purposes;
- private entertainment, food, beverages, plaques, awards, scholarships, prize money or certificates;
- projects which are restricted to private or exclusive participation;
- regranting (using County funds to underwrite local grants programs see "Glossary");
- contributions and donations;
- any other expenditure not authorized by Chapter 112 of the Florida Statutes or Brevard County Codes and Policies or any other law.
