

# Request to Extend Existing EMS Billing Agreement with Advanced Data Processing, Inc. for 90 days

### SUBJECT:

Request To Extend Existing Agreement With Advanced Data Processing, Inc, A Subsidiary Of Intermedix Corporation, For A Period Of Ninety (90) Days.

#### REQUESTED ACTION:

Fire Rescue Department requests approval to extend its current contract with Advanced Data Processing, Inc., a Subsidiary of InterMedix Corporation for a period of ninety (90) days to June 2, 2019, to facilitate the execution of the Request For Proposal (RFP) process. Advanced Data Processing/InterMedix performs patient billing services for the Department's ambulance services.

## SUMMARY EXPLANATION and BACKGROUND:

As a result of a competitive RFP, Advanced Data Processing/InterMedix was selected to perform patient billing services for the Department's Emergency Medical Services (EMS). The agreement's effective start date was March 3, 2014; this was two year agreement commencing on the effective date with automatic renewals for three one-year periods. The agreement expires on March 2, 2019.

An administrative error drives this request. BOCC initially approved this contract in regular session on 29 April 2014 corresponding to the date entered into Contract Management System (CM) as the effective start and expiration date. When in fact the contract effective dates are a month earlier. This oversight drives the need for a 90 day extension to the current contract.

In order to provide sufficient time to conduct a competitive RFP process for EMS billing services, Fire Rescue is requesting approval to extend the current agreement for a period of ninety (90) days (through 2 June 2019) to facilitate the execution of the RFP process.

This action has been coordinated with the county attorney. Risk coordinated with original

contract - which this extends. Risk and CA will be involved in follow on RFP process.

# AMENDMENT EXTENDING EXISTING CONTRACT FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES BILLING AND RELATED PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

THIS CONTRACT AMENDMENT is made and entered into this 26<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2019, by and between the following Parties: Advanced Data Processing, Inc. a Subsidiary of InterMedix Corporation, and the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida.

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Parties previously entered into a Contract on March 3, 2014, to perform patient billing services and related professional services for Fire Rescue's Emergency Medical Services (EMS) within Brevard County; and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to extend the Contract term for an additional ninety (90) days to provide sufficient time to conduct a competitive request for proposal process for these services.
