### SUBJECT:

Requesting the Attorney General's Office to issue an opinion regarding whether it is lawful for CRAs to expend funds on promotional events such as festivals before completing infrastructure projects.

#### REQUESTED ACTION:

Direct the County Attorney's Office to request an opinion from the Florida Attorney General's Office on the following question:

Is it lawful for Community Redevelopment Agencies to expend funds from its redevelopment trust fund on promotional events such as street festivals, whether directly or through a grant to a third-party, before completion of infrastructure projects included in its Redevelopment Plan.

## SUMMARY EXPLANATION and BACKGROUND:

A question has been raised regarding whether it is acceptable for CRAs to expend their respective trust funds on promotional events such as festivals.

The purpose of this request is to assist all parties involved in resolving this questions. While an opinion of the Attorney General is not binding, such an opinion on the direct question-at-hand would be highly persuasive and could act to prevent future conflict with our municipal partners.
