Pursuant to the provisions of Section 125.66, Florida Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners shall hold a public hearing at 9:00AM or as soon thereafter as the item may come up, on **January 23, 2018, to** consider adoption of an ordinance amending Section 102-122 of the Brevard County Code of Ordinances. The title of the Ordinance to be considered by the Board of County Commissioners of Brevard County, Florida, on that date reads as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA AMENDING SECTION 102-122 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA; AMENDING SECTION 102-122(a) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, RELATING TO PLEDGING TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX REVENUES FOR REPAYMENT OF REVENUE BONDS; PROVIDING FOR THE CORRECTION OF A SCRIVENER'S ERROR; PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF SECTION 102-122(a) TO CONFORM WITH THE REVISED CODE NUMBERING OF THE TOURIST DEVELOPMENT BUDGET PLAN; PROVIDING FOR THE CONFORMITY OF SECTION 102-122(a) WITH THE STATUTORILY ALLOWED PURPOSES FOR WHICH TOURIST DEVELOPMENT TAX REVENUES MAY BE PLEDGED TO SECURE AND LIQUIDATE REVENUE BONDS AS SET FORTH IN SECTION 125.0104(5)(d), FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CODE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Interested parties may appear at the January 23, 2018, meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed ordinance.
