# **Fiscal Impact:**

Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Disbursements to the School Board are currently budgeted at \$22,379,010, contingent on the actual collection amounts. This disbursement would allow for \$6,847,549.45 to be disbursed to the School Board.

# **Requested Action:**

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the disbursement of Educational Facilities Impact Fees in the amount of \$6,847,549.45 to the School Board of Brevard County in accordance with the terms of the interlocal agreement and authorize the Budget Office to execute necessary Budget Change requests to implement this disbursement.

# **Summary Explanation and Background:**

On July 15, 2024, the Impact Fee Advisory Committees for the North and South Educational Facilities Impact Fee Benefit Districts met and by unanimous vote adopted project funding recommendations for consideration by the School Board. The Impact Advisory Committees consist of one representative from each of the following: the Brevard County School Board, Brevard County and each municipality within the Benefit District that has entered in an interlocal agreement with the County to participate in the Educational Facilities Impact Fee Program.

The School Board approved the funding recommendations on July 30, 2024, to include the below projects-

North Benefit District - \$1,418,129.12 - Separate Day School South Benefit District - \$5,429,420.33 - South Area Capacity

#### Discussion

Brevard County collects educational facilities impact fees from residential development for construction of educational facilities or capital improvements that provide educational capacity in the Impact Fee Benefit District from which the funds were collected. The funds may be used on capacity projects identified in the Five-Year District Facilities Work Program.

The process by which funds are allocated to projects is outlined in the Interlocal Agreement between Brevard County and the School Board. Each Benefit District (North and South) has an Educational Facilities Impact Fee Benefit District Advisory Committee (IFBDAC) that includes the School Board, County and applicable municipal representatives. Approximately every quarter, the District Advisory Committees make a recommendation to the School Board. The School Board approves or modifies the recommendation and then submits the funding request to Brevard County for approval by the Board of County Commissioners. The process can take 2-4 months before the funds are received by the District.

The Board action requested allocates the impact fee revenue collected through the quarter ending June 30, 2024.

The Impact Fee Benefit District Advisory Committees met on July 15, 2024. The Committees' recommendations for new educational facilities impact fees through June 30, 2024 are summarized as follows:

- Allocate new impact fees collected in South Benefit District to South Area Capacity \$5,429,420.33
- Allocate new impact fees collected in North Benefit District to Separate Day School \$1,418,129.12

The South Area Capacity project is funding potential new capacity in the south area of the county. This category is set up to fund either elementary, secondary, or a combination school (such as a K-8). The initial planning is for up to 3 projects in the Palm Bay area, including the San Filippo site, Westside/Bayside site and a developer site. Ideally, all 3 of these projects would move to the concept development and design phase.

The award of the Request for Qualifications for design services for the new Separate Day School (planned at Kennedy Middle School) will be considered at the July 30, 2024 School Board Meeting. The North Benefit District impact fee allocation is intended for this project.
