SUBJECT:	Acknowledge Application, Re: Subsequent Local Workforce Development Area (LWDB) Designation .
DEPT/OFFICE:	Brevard Workforce Development Board D/B/A CareerSource Brevard

Requested Action:

The Brevard County Board of County Commissioners is requested to acknowledge the CareerSource Brevard (CSB) Application for Subsequent Local Workforce Development Area Designation which was transmitted to the State of Florida, Department of Economic Opportunity as required.

Summary Explanation & Background:

In Brevard County, which is LWDB 13 in the state workforce system, the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners serves as the Chief Elected Official.

Based on the Workforce Innovation Opportunity Act (WIOA), LWDB's are required to submit information to the State Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) indicating that the Chief Elected Official "certifies" that CareerSource Brevard (CSB) has performed successfully and sustained fiscal integrity for subsequent designation as an existing LWDB. Specifically, the document certifies that CSB has met or exceeded the adjusted levels of performance for primary indicators of performance for the last two consecutive years and the local area has not failed the same individual measure for the last two consecutive program years. In 2015, WIOA allowed existing LWDB's an initial designation and to remain in place through June 30, 2017. "Subsequent Designation" allows CSB to continue as the designee into the future.

The request for the designation form was received with little notice from DEO and in order to meet the required April 14, 2017 due date, the County Manager executed the form. CSB submitted the form to DEO by the due date. The CareerSource Florida Board of Directors approved the designation of CareerSource Brevard along with 23 other LWDB designations at their May 17th Board of Directors meeting.


