ORDINANCE NO. 2017-

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTIONS 98-101 THROUGH 98-112 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF BREVARD COUNTY AND THEREBY DISSOLVING THE PORT ST. JOHN DEPENDENT SPECIAL DISTRICT FLORIDA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, the Port St. John Dependent Special District was created by the Board of County Commissioners of Brevard County, Florida on July 2, 1996; and

WHEREAS, Fla. Stat. § 189.071(1) provides that "the merger or dissolution of a dependent special district may be effectuated by an ordinance of the local general-purpose governmental entity wherein the geographical area of the district or districts is located..."; and

WHEREAS, Sec. 98-103, Code of Ordinances of Brevard County, Florida states that "the Port St. John Dependent Special District may be dissolved by an ordinance repealing the provisions of this article..."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. Sections 98-101 through 98-112, Code of Ordinances of Brevard County, Florida, is hereby repealed. The Port St. John Dependent Special District is dissolved effective January 1, 2018.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect on January 1, 2018
