It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners approves the recognizing Give a Little Hope, Inc for their devotion to helping local cancer-affected families.

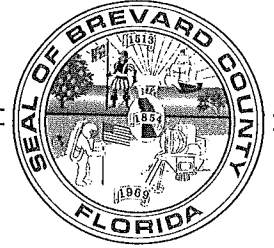

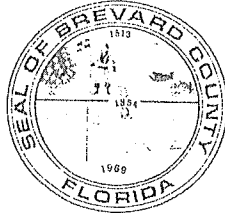

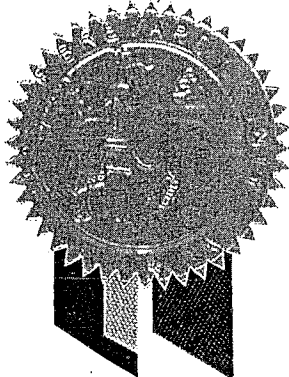
