Time Extension Request for the City of Melbourne Grant Street Water Reclamation Facility Upgrade, Save Our Indian River Lagoon Project - District 3

Fiscal Impact:

This Board action does not change the funding amount, only the timing of the anticipated cost-share distributions from the Save Our Indian River Lagoon Trust Fund (Fund 1260)

Requested Action:

It is requested the Board authorize the Chair to execute Amendment 3 to extend the completion date for the SOIRL 19-59 Agreement with the City of Melbourne

Summary Explanation and Background:

The City of Melbourne Grant Street Water Reclamation Facility Upgrade Project is a substitute project approved by the County Commission in 2019 and remains included in the current Save Our Indian River Lagoon Project Plan. This project will reduce an estimated 18,052 pounds per year of total nitrogen and 9,761 pounds per year of total phosphorus from entering the lagoon through additional treatment of domestic wastewater to be reused for irrigation.

The original Agreement was executed on November 4, 2019, for \$5,415,600.00 with a completion date of March 31, 2023. Amendment 1 was executed on April 30, 2020, to revise the eligible Save Our Indian River Lagoon Tax Funding Cost Share from \$300 to \$375 per pound of total nitrogen removed and update the County Project Manager. Amendment 2 was executed on March 23, 2023, to extend the completion date by six months to September 30, 2023, and update the liability and insurance, termination, severability, and E-Verify sections of the contract. This requested amendment extends the completion date by 30 months to March 31, 2026.

The City experienced delays for a number of factors. Due to cost escalations, the City had to obtain approval for additional low-interest loan funding from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection State Revolving Fund program. The loan agreement for \$12 million dollars was executed in May 2022 with an additional loan agreement for the balance of the necessary funding to be determined after bids are received. Additionally, the City originally intended to implement improvements to the Grant Street and DB Lee Water Reclamation Facilities in a single contract. The City decided to separate the current single construction contract into two separate contracts to increase the number of construction contractors bidding for these projects.

AMENDMENT 3 TO THE SAVE OUR INDIAN RIVER LAGOON PROJECT COST-SHARE FUNDING INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AND THE CITY OF MELBOURNE, FLORIDA

AGREEMENT NUMBER: SOIRL 19-59

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into by and between Brevard County, Florida, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (hereinafter "COUNTY"), and the City of Melbourne, Florida, a Florida municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida (hereinafter "CITY").

WHEREAS, the parties have previously entered into that certain Save Our Indian River Lagoon Project Cost-Share Funding Interlocal Agreement No. SOIRL 19-59 on November 4, 2019 ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties previously entered into Amendment 1 to the Agreement on April 30, 2020, to update the COUNTY Project Manager and Cost-Share Amount from \$5,415,600 to \$6,769,500; and

WHEREAS, the parties previously entered into Amendment 2 to the Agreement on March 23, 2023 to extend the expiration date by six months to September 30, 2023, update the Liability and Insurance, Termination, Severability, and E-Verify language; and

WHEREAS, the CITY has completed the full design, but experienced delays in bidding the project due to revisions and legal review; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants herein contained, the parties hereby agree as follows:

- 1. Section 3. Terms and Extensions subsection 3.a. is amended to read as follows:
 - a. The term of this Agreement is from the date upon which the last party has dated and executed the same ("Effective Date") until March 31, 2026 ("Completion Date"). CITY shall not commence the Project until any required submittals are received and approved. Time is of the essence for every aspect of this Agreement, including any time extensions.
- 2. All terms and conditions of the Agreement, and any amendments or modifications thereto, are incorporated herein by this reference, not inconsistent with the provisions of this Second Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect.



RE: Save Our Indian River Lagoon (SOIRL) Funding for the City of Melbourne Biological Nutrient Removal (BNR) Improvements at the Grant Street WRF Agreement No. SOIRL 19-59; Request for Time Extension

Dear Ms. Barker:

The City of Melbourne has received a \$6.77 million dollar grant from the Save Our Indian River Lagoon (SOIRL) to partially fund construction of biological nutrient removal (BNR) improvements at the Grant Street Water Reclamation Facility (WRF). A recent update to the agreement provides for the completion of Task 2 Bidding and Construction phase of the work by September 30, 2023. To date the City has not requested any reimbursement of funds from the SOIRL program.

This City has experienced delays in moving the project forward for a number of factors as described below:

- 1) The City was required to obtain additional low interest loan funding from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection State Revolving Fund program to fund the balance of the overall project. The loan agreement for the initial \$12 million dollars was executed in May 2022 with an additional loan agreement for the balance of the necessary funding to be determined after the actual bids are received by the City.
- 2) During the project bidding process, the City Team determined it would be beneficial to separate the current single construction contract into two separate contracts, Contracts A and B, to increase the number of Construction Contractor's bidding. The two contracts are: A) the Grant Street WRF Nutrient Removal and Improvements Project, and B) the DB Lee WRF and the Grant St WRF Biosolids Improvements Project. The Grant Street WRF project involves the BNR improvements which will remove significant nitrogen and phosphorus loadings from the Indian River Lagoon (IRL). The Biosolids Improvements Project will improve solids stabilization and handling facilities at both the Grant St and DB Lee WRFs. This project will reduce the volume of treated biosolids being land applied by approximately 30%, and reduce the nitrogen and phosphorus released from the biosolids in the aerobic digestion process recycle

streams. These WRF improvements are being undertaken to provide significant environmental benefits to the IRL. Table 1 below delineates the current schedule for this Grant St WRF Project.
