Encourage discussion among Commissioners about a potential future agenda item regarding parking fees.

## **Summary Explanation and Background:**

The Tourism Development Council recently discussed the possibility of implementing a parking fee at Lori Wilson Park in Cocoa Beach. The fee would be equally applied to county and non-county visitors, with the revenue being used to offset maintenance costs at the park.

While the park has improved substantially, including upgrades to the dog park and the replacement of beach crossovers and shower towers, there remain profound needs in the park including removal of invasive species and completion of boardwalk replacement.

By dedicating user fees to the park's upkeep, the County can reduce and possibly avoid the need to draw from the general fund or other traditional budgeted dollars for parks.

It is District 2's position that any funds raised through such a program must be used for the maintenance or improvement of that specific park and that costs not exceed \$5 per spot per day.
