Approval, Re: Lease Renewal for Nana's House - District 5

# Fiscal Impact:

Revenue of the annual rent of \$1.00 will be deposited in the General Fund.

## Dept/Office:

Public Works Department/Facilities

### Requested Action:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the Chair to execute the Lease Renewal, and associated resolution, allowing the non-competitive lease of County property located at 4090 Minton Road in Palm Bay to Nana's Children's Home ("Nana's House"). A **majority plus one vote** of the Board is required to approve this item per Section 2-247, Brevard County Code. It is further requested the Board authorize the County Manager to execute any and all no-cost contract-related documents contingent upon review and approval by the County Attorney's Office, Risk Management, and Purchasing Services.

## **Summary Explanation and Background:**

On December 3, 2013, the Board approved a lease agreement for Nana's House located at 4090 Minton Road in Palm Bay (the "Lease Agreement"). The Lease Agreement provided for an initial term of ten years with two five-year renewal options; however, there was no delegation of authority identified to execute the renewal options. The current lease expired on December 3, 2023. Nana's House desires to renew the Lease Agreement with the County, retroactively commencing on December 4, 2023, and continuing through December 3, 2028. This will be the first renewal of the Lease Agreement.

Pursuant to Section 2-247, Brevard County Code, the County may lease County-owned real property to a nonprofit corporation performing a function or service that promotes the public health, safety, or welfare and could be provided by a government agency if certain findings are made by the Board of County Commissioners. Specifically, if the Board is satisfied that the proposed use of the property will serve the public interest; will serve a public purpose; is in the best interest of the County; and finds that the property is either likely to be not needed for County purposes in the future or will be used in a manner compatible with County purposes, then the Board may enter into the lease. If the lease is of nominal value, then a majority plus one vote of the Board shall be required. For purposes of Section 2-247, "nominal value" shall mean a token value that does not bear a direct relationship to the fair market value. In accordance with Administrative Order 29, the Lease Renewal has been reviewed and approved by the County Attorney's Office, Risk Management, and Purchasing Services.

# First Renewal to Lease Agreement Nana's Children's Home

This First Renewal to Lease Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "First Renewal") is made and entered into the date of last signature below, by and between Brevard County, Florida, though the Board of County Commissioners of Brevard County, Florida, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (hereinafter referred to as "County"), and Nana's Children's Home, Inc., a/k/a Nana's House, a Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation licensed to do business in the State of Florida (hereinafter referred to as "Lessee").

#### Witnesseth:

Whereas, the County previously entered into an agreement with Lessee on December 3, 2013, for the lease of County-owned property located at 4090 Minton Road, Palm Bay, Florida (hereinafter referred to as the "Original Contract"), which is incorporated herein by this reference; and

Whereas, the initial term of the Original Contract was for ten years, beginning on December 4, 2013, and terminating on December 3, 2023; and

Whereas, the Original Contract allowed for two five-year consecutive renewal options; and

Whereas, the Parties hereto desire to enter into this First Renewal to exercise the first five-year renewal option thereby continuing the Original Contract from December 4, 2023, through December 3, 2028.

**Now, therefore,** in consideration of the premises and mutual covenants contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

- 1. Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.
- 2. In accordance with the Term provision in the Original Contract, the Parties mutually agree that the Original Contract is hereby reinstated and renewed for an additional period of five (5) years. The Lease term will be considered to run from December 4, 2023, and continuing through December 3, 2028 ("renewal term"). The Lessee is responsible for any and all liability and indemnification requirements during this renewal term.
- 3. All terms and conditions of the Original Contract, and any amendments or modifications made thereto, which are incorporated herein by this reference, that are not inconsistent with the provisions of this First Renewal, shall remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties hereto have executed this First Renewal on the date last written below, which may be done so in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original contract when executed by the respective Party's duly authorized representatives.

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 23-1**45

A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO SECTION 125.38, FLORIDA STATUTES, AND SECTION 2-247, BREVARD COUNTY CODE, AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TO LEASE COUNTY-OWNED PROPERTY TO NANA'S CHILDREN'S HOME, INC., A FLORIDA NOTFOR-PROFIT CORPORATION.

WHEREAS, the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, hereinafter the "COUNTY", wishes to continue to lease the building on property located at 4090 Minton Road, Palm Bay, Florida, to NANA'S CHILDREN'S HOME, INC., hereinafter NANA'S HOUSE, a not-for-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, NANA'S HOUSE provides a group children's home for neglected, abused, needy, and/or abandoned children between the ages of 0-18 years of age whose parent(s)/guardian(s) are unable to care for the children due to separation, abandonment, illness, death, etc.; and

**WHEREAS**, the PARTIES previously entered into a lease agreement in 2013, which is incorporated herein by this reference, for NANA'S HOUSE to provide the services identified above at 4090 Minton Road, hereinafter the Property; and

**WHEREAS**, the COUNTY hereby finds that NANA'S HOUSE continues to provide services that promote the public health, safety, and welfare.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct, and incorporated herein by this reference.
- 2. The COUNTY previously entered into a lease agreement with NANA'S HOUSE, a not-for-profit organization. The Lease Agreement is hereby renewed for an additional period of five (5) years; the first of two renewal terms contemplated in the original Lease Agreement.
- 3. The COUNTY finds that the continued use of the Property serves the public interest, serves a public purpose, and is in the best interest of the COUNTY.
- 4. The Property is not likely to be needed for County purposes in the future.

5. The lease payment for such lease shall continue to be one dollar (\$1.00) per year.

This Resolution shall take effect on the date approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Brevard County, Florida.
