It is requested by the Melbourne Tillman Water Control District that the Board of County Commissioners adopt the attached Resolution approving user fees for the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District for FY 2018-2019 and authorize the Chairman to sign the Resolution at the August 21, 2018 regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION and BACKGROUND:

The user fees requested and recommended by the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District's Board of Directors represents a 10% increase in each of the FY 2018-2019 rates categories as follows:

- Residential from \$21.31 per lot or acre to \$23.44
- Agriculture from \$7.45 per lot or acre to \$8.20
- Commercial from \$41.36 per lot or acre to \$45.50

RESOLUTION NO.2018-_____

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE AND ADOPT USER FEES PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 2001-336, LAWS OF FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF THE MELBOURNE-TILLMAN WATER CONTROL DISTRICT TO LEVY USER FEES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019 AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 2001-336, Laws of Florida, provides the authority for the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District to levy user fees; and

WHEREAS, the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District is a dependent special district of the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners whose charges and budget are subject to the approval of the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the user fees proposed by the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District have been advertised and the subject of public hearings conducted by the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners on August 7, 2018 and August 21, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the user fees to be levied represent a 10% increase over current rates, are stated in this resolution, and have been publicly read in full.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

1. The Board of Directors of the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District has adopted the following classifications (categories of land use) to be assessed as follows:

CLASSIFICATION I, RESIDENTIAL -	\$23.44 per lot, acre or portion thereof
CLASSIFICATION II, AGRICULTURAL -	\$ 8.20 per lot, acre or portion thereof

CLASSIFICATION III, COMMERCIAL - \$45.40 per lot, acre or
portion thereof

This levy has been adopted for the Budget of the District for the Fiscal Year beginning October 1, 2018, and ending September 30, 2019.

2. The aforementioned classifications and fees of the Melbourne-Tillman Water Control District are hereby ratified and affirmed for the Budget and Fiscal Year 2018-2019.

3. A certified copy of this Resolution shall be filed with the Tax Collector of Brevard County, Florida.

4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
