

To Brevard County Board of County Commissioners
and Brevard County Management,

As of February 4, 2022 we received notice of a Space X request to build a wastewater management facility in District 1. This permit request has been published by the Department of Environmental Protection. The proposed permit says the facility is planning to release 3,602.9 gallons per day (or .003 MGD) of non-processed wastewater into Oyster Prong. Oyster Prong is a bay and canal located just north of State Road 405 on Merritt Island. This bay connects directly to the North Indian River directly across from Titusville. The public notice informs that if the Department of Environmental Protection does not receive sufficient requests for a public hearing, the permit will be given immediately. All requests must be made by March 5th, 2022.

Whereas one of the top 3 pillars for the Libertarian Party of Brevard is the protection and correction of the Indian River Lagoon, and

Whereas another one of the top 3 pillars for the Libertarian Party of Brevard is an increase in government transparency within the borders of our county, and

Whereas the Indian River Lagoon is already in a crisis and Brevard County Government itself has expenditures prior to this facility being built,


We hereby formally request Brevard County and the Board of County Commissioners to send a letter and a formal request to have this public hearing to establish the seriousness of the proposed situation, the aftereffects, and the plan to ensure no harm comes to the Indian River Lagoon. We would also like to ask, your request to include that the public hearing be held here in Brevard County with a scientific presentation to the Brevard County public about the construction of this facility.

Notice Text

The Department of Environmental Protection gives notice of its preparation of a draft permit to SpaceX Florida (USPS), Paul Sutter, PO Box 286, Cape Canaveral, Florida 32920 for the Hangar X. This permit authorizes the permittee to construct and operate a 0.003 mgd industrial wastewater treatment facility which would discharge 0.003 mgd of non-process wastewater to Oyster Prong. The facility will be located at Latitude: 28 32' 31.36" N Longitude: 80 39' 52.54" W on Roberts Road & State Road 3, Merritt Island, Florida 32953 in Brevard County. The Department has assigned permit file number FLOA00032-001-IW7D to the proposed project. The permit application file and supporting data are available for public inspection during normal business hours, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays, at the Department's Central District Office, 3319 Maguire Blvd, Suite 232, Orlando, Florida 32803-3767, at phone number (407)897-4100.

NOTICE OF RIGHTS

The Department intends to issue the permit unless as a result of public comment appropriate changes are made. Written Comments or Request for Public Meeting

Any interested person may submit written comments on the Department's proposed permitting decision or may submit a written request for a public meeting to Randall Cunningham, 3319 Maguire Blvd, Suite 232, Orlando, Florida 32803-3767, in accordance with Rule 62-620.555, F.A.C. The comments or request for a public meeting must contain the information set forth below and must be received in the Department's Central District Office.

The comments or request for a public meeting must contain the following information:

- (a) The commenter's name, address, and telephone number; the applicant's name and address; the Department permit file number; and the county in which the project is proposed;
- (b) A statement of how and when notice of the Department's action or proposed action was received;
- (c) A statement of the facts the Department should consider in making the final decision;
- (d) A statement of which rules or statutes require reversal or modification of the Department's action or proposed action; and
- (e) If desired, a request that a public meeting be scheduled, including a statement of the nature of the issues proposed to be raised at the meeting.

If a public meeting is held, any person may submit oral or written statements and data at the public meeting on the Department's proposed action. As a result of significant public comment, the Department's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this draft permit.


