Approval RE: Disbursement of Educational Facilities Impact Fees (Districts 1-5)

Fiscal Impact:

Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Disbursements to the School Board are currently budgeted at \$22,379,010, contingent on the actual collection amounts. This disbursement would allow for \$6,183,887.37 to be disbursed to the School Board.

Requested Action:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners authorize the disbursement of Educational Facilities Impact Fees in the amount of \$6,183,887.37 to the School Board of Brevard County in accordance with the terms of the interlocal agreement and authorize the Budget Office to execute necessary Budget Change Requests to implement this disbursement.

Summary Explanation and Background:

On October 16, 2023 the Impact Fee Advisory Committees for the North and South Educational Facilities Impact Fee Benefit Districts met and adopted project funding recommendations for consideration by the School Board. The Impact Fee Advisory Committees consist of one representative from each of the following: the Brevard County School Board, Brevard County and each municipality within the Benefit District that has entered into an interlocal agreement with the County to participate in the Educational Facilities Impact Fee Program.

The attached letter from the School Board requests the referenced funding and includes minutes from the October 24, 2023 School Board meeting. At that meeting, the School Board approved the funding recommendations to include the below projects -

Central Area Secondary - \$4,660,898.99 Debt Service - \$1,522,988.38

Discussion

Brevard County collects educational facilities impact fees from residential development for construction of educational facilities or capital improvements that provide educational capacity in the Impact Fee Benefit District from which the funds were collected. The funds may be used on capacity projects identified in the Five-Year District Facilities Work Program.

The process by which funds are allocated to projects is outlined in the Interlocal Agreement between Brevard County and the School Board. Each Benefit District (North and South) has an Educational Facilities Impact Fee Benefit District Advisory Committee that includes the School Board, County and applicable municipal representatives. Approximately every quarter, the District Advisory Committees make a recommendation to the School Board. The School Board approves or modifies the recommendation and then submits the funding request to Brevard County for approval by the Board of County Commissioners. The process can take 2-4 months before the funds are received by the District.

The Board action requested allocates the impact fee revenue collected through the quarter ending September 30, 2023.

The Impact Fee Benefit District Advisory Committees met on October 16, 2023. The Committees' recommendations for new educational facilities impact fees through September 30, 2023 are attached to this agenda memo and are summarized as follows:

- Allocate new impact fees collected in South Benefit District to Central Area Secondary \$4,660,898.99
- Allocate new impact fees collected in North Benefit District to Debt Service \$1,522,988.38

The Central Area Secondary project includes the classroom building addition at Viera High School and the new middle school on the site next to Viera High School (referred to as "Middle School X" in our Five-Year District Facilities Work Program). The Viera High School classroom addition project is fully funded, so the proposed allocation will be used for the new middle school. The financing plan for the middle school was presented to the Impact Fee Benefit District Committees, noting that the District staff will request allocation of the South Benefit District impact fees to the new middle school to minimize the amount of financing required.

The current South Area Elementary Capacity project is the classroom addition at West Melbourne School for Science. The project is under design and the cost estimate is \$8.2 million and is close to fully funded with impact feed previously allocated for the project. The school capacity project in South Brevard is expected to be located in the Palm Bay area based on growth projections.

The allocation of north area impact fees to debt service (\$1,522,988.38) will reduce the amount of local capital funds required to pay debt service. Capital funds saved can then be designated for the classroom building project at Mila Elementary, which is located in the North Benefit District. The Mila project is in the design phase. Since educational impact fees can only be used for additional capacity, a building replacement project would not be an eligible use. Consequently, utilizing the north area funds for

debt service and designating the resulting available capital funds for the Mila Elementary project will keep the investment of north area funds in the north area.

Recommendation

Approve the recommendations of the Educational Facilities Impact Fee Benefit District Advisory Committees:

- Allocate new impact fees collected in South Benefit District to Central Area Secondary \$4,660,898.99
- Allocate new impact fees collected in North Benefit District to Debt Service \$1,522,988.38

Authorize the Superintendent, or designee, to request Brevard County approve the allocation request and disburse the Educational Impact Fees available through June 30, 2023.

Approve designating \$1,522,988.38 in capital funds for the Mila Elementary classroom building project pending approval and disbursement of the recommended allocation of educational facilities impact fees by the Brevard County Commission.
