Requested Action:

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners consider adopting an Ordinance rescinding the Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption for Dark Storm Industries, LLC.

Summary Explanation and Background:

On April 20, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners granted Dark Storm Industries, LLC, an ad valorem tax exemption for a period of 10 years and 100 percent on real and tangible property added to the County's assessment roll. In order to remain eligible for the County's Ad Valorem Tax Exemption Program, Dark Storm Industries, LLC, would need to maintain their eligibility as set forth in Ordinance 2021-10.

The economic ad valorem tax exemption was granted for the piece of property purchased from Brevard County in Enterprise Park, more specifically a parcel of land lying in Section 4, Township 23 South, Range 35 East and being part of parcel "D" as shown on the plat of Enterprise Park as recorded in plat book 32, page 74 of public records of Brevard County, Florida. On November 14, 2023, the County approved purchasing this piece of property back from Dark Storm Industries, LLC.

A certified letter has been sent to Dark Storm Industries, LLC, notifying them that the Board of County Commissioners would consider rescinding their Ordinance based upon Dark Storm Industries, LLC, not undertaking the new business at the location in Enterprise Park as designated in Section 1 (f) of Ordinance 2021-10.

ORDINANCE NO. 2023-<u>34</u>

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 2021-10 GRANTING TO DARK STORM INDUSTRIES, LLC, CERTAIN AD VALOREM TAX EXEMPTIONS, FOR FAILURE TO MEET THE CRITERIA FOR SUCH EXEMPTIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, DARK STORM INDUSTRIES, LLC, Titusville, Florida, no longer meets the criteria of Section 196.012 (14) Florida Statutes and Brevard County Ordinance 2021-10.

NOW THEREFORE, LET IT BE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance 2021-10, relating to the economic development ad valorem exemption granted to Dark Storm Industries, LLC, (parcel of land lying in Section 4, Township 23 South, Range 35 East and being part of parcel "D" as shown on the plat of Enterprise Park as recorded in plat book 32, page 74 of public records of Brevard County, Florida) is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Effective Date - This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and filing as provided by law. A certified copy of the Ordinance shall be filed with the Office of the Secretary of State, State of Florida, within ten (10) days of enactment.

Section 3. It is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners that the provisions of this ordinance amend the Code of Ordinances of Brevard County, Florida, as applicable.

On April 20, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners granted Dark Storm Industries, LLC, an ad valorem tax exemption for a period of 10 years and 100 percent on real and tangible property added to the County's assessment roll. Ordinance 2021-10 sets forth the requirements to maintain eligibility to participate in the County's Ad Valorem Tax Exemption Program.

ORDINANCE NO. 2021-_10

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AD VALOREM EXEMPTION TO DARK STORM INDUSTRIES, LLC; SPECIFYING THE ITEMS EXEMPTED; PROVIDING THE EXPIRATION DATE OF THE EXEMPTION; FINDING THAT THE BUSINESS MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 196.1995, FLORIDA STATUTES; PROVIDING FOR PROOF OF ELIGIBILITY FOR EXEMPTION FOR DARK STORM INDUSTRIES, LLC; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, economic development and the creation of jobs are a priority of the Brevard County Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the Brevard County citizens voted to provide economic incentives to new and expanding businesses in the November 2014 general election; and

WHEREAS, Dark Storm Industries, LLC has requested that the Board of County Commissioners exempt ad valorem taxes for real and tangible personal property added to Brevard County tax rolls at a parcel of land lying in Section 4, Township 23 South, Range 35 East and being a part of parcel "D" as shown on the plat of Enterprise Park as recorded in plat book 32, page 74 of public records of Brevard County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Commission of Florida's Space Coast has recommended approval of the exemption for Dark Storm Industrics, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the Property Appraisor has provided the Board of County Commissioners with its report as required by Section 196.1995(9), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Dark Storm Industries, LLC, meets the requirements of Section 196.012(14), Florida Statutes for a new business in Brevard County; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 102 entitled "Taxation"; Article IV entitled "Ad Valorem Property Taxation", of the Code of Ordinances of Brevard County, Florida shall be amended to include a new section 102-2_as follows:

- (a) An Economic Development Ad Valorem Tax Exemption is hereby granted to Dark Storm Industries, LLC (hereafter referred to as "the Company"), for:
 - 1. 100 percent a) of the assessed value of all improvements to real property made by or for the use of a new business (not to exceed the amount identified in the Company's application for exemption) as determined by the Property Appraiser for the first year after substantial completion of those improvements; and b) of the assessed value of all tangible personal property of such new business in place during that first year (not to exceed the amount identified in the Company's application for exemption), or

- 2. 0 percent a) of the assessed value of all added improvements to real property made to facilitate the expansion of an existing business in the first year of assessment after substantial completion of those improvements (not to exceed the amount identified in the Company's application for exemption) and b) of the assessed value of the net increase in all tangible personal property acquired to facilitate such expansion of an existing business during that first year (not to exceed the amount identified in the Company's application for exemption).
- (b) The total amount of revenue available to the County from ad valorem tax sources for the current fiscal year is \$ 248,187,956 ; \$ 1,276,553 is lost to the County for the current fiscal year by virtue of exemptions currently in effect from previous years.
- (c) The tax exemption hereby granted shall be for a term of ten (10) year(s) commencing with the first year the new or expanded facility and tangible personal property are added to the assessment roll.
- (d) In accordance with the findings of the Board of County Commissioners and the Property Appraiser, the property hereby exempted from ad valorem tax exemption meets the definition of a new business, as defined by Section 196.012(14), Florida Statutes.
- The Company shall submit to the County Manager at the beginning of each year an annual report providing evidence of continued compliance with the definition of a new business by creating and/or maintaining the anticipated jobs in the supplemental application for Brevard County's economic development ad valorem tax exemption program for each of the ten (10) year(s) during which the Company is eligible to receive ad valorem tax exemption. If the annual report is not received, or if the annual report indicates the Company, no longer meets the criteria of Section 196.012(14), Florida Statutes, or is not meeting the anticipated job creation goals in the supplemental application for Brevard County's economic development ad valorem tax exemption program, the County Manager shall make a report to the Board of County Commissioners for consideration of revocation of this Ordinance granting the tax exemption.
- (f) If the County Manager or designee receives written notice that the company qualifying for an ad valorem tax abatement under the authority of this ordinance has decided not to undertake or complete the new business or expansion of an existing business, including improvements to real property or acquisition of taxable tangible personal property, or has not timely provided the number of jobs qualifying the new business or expansion of an existing business for the ad valorem tax exemption granted under this section, the exemption granted shall be void, shall not take effect and shall not be implemented. If such a notice is received, the foregoing provision shall be self-executing and no further action of the Board of County Commissioners will be required to void the granted exemption. Upon the County's receipt of any such notice, the county manager or designee shall forward the notice to the Property Appraiser along with a copy of this subsection of the ordinance.
- (g) If, upon discovery of the Company's failure to qualify for the ad valorem tax exemption granted by this ordinance, the Board of County Commissioners may revoke this Ordinance, and the company shall reimburse those County ad valorem taxes abated in favor of the

Company for that period of time that it was determined that the Company no longer met the criteria of Section 196.012(14), Florida Statutes.

Section 2. Severability - If any provision of this Ordinance is held to be illegal or invalid, the other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Effective Date - This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon filing as provided by law. A certified copy of the Ordinance shall be filed with the Office of the Secretary of State, State of Florida within ten days of enactment.

Dark Storm Industries, LLC (Project Freedom) is a federally licensed firearms manufacturer currently located in New York. The company now produces many of the components for their firearms in their own CNC advanced manufacturing facility. The company currently has 40+ employees, annual sales exceeding \$12,000,000 and a 6-month backlog of new orders.

The company's growth trajectory requires expansion of its manufacturing capabilities. The expansion of manufacturing capabilities provides the opportunity to relocate to a more economically desirable location. Products manufactured by the company are shipped across the United States. The site search and the final location determination are heavily driven by a variety of economic factors, including labor costs and taxes. The initial site selection process included Florida, Georgia, North Carolina, South Carolina and Texas.

Project Freedom is contemplating building a new 25,000 sq. ft. facility that will include manufacturing, assembly, warehousing, shipping, sales, marketing and accounting. The new corporate headquarters will dramatically expand the company's production capabilities and allow ongoing sales and workforce growth. The site under consideration in Brevard County provides for an additional 20,000 sq. ft. phase 2 expansion at a future date. The Company projects it will employ 50 people with an average wage in excess of \$50,000.00 as indicated in our application. In addition to the base wage, employees will enjoy a competitive package of benefits. The company expects to spend \$2,000,000 to purchase land and construct the building and invest an additional \$1,200,000 in equipment.

Given the nature of our product, American-made components are an important part of our brand and we are more likely to purchase items such as raw materials, packaging, etc. from a local supplier instead of from overseas.

The company has pending offers from other Counties within Florida which include 100% Ad Valorem Tax Abatement for 10 years. Our business is extremely competitive. The costs associated with taxes, wages, as well as land and construction, are the major factors in making our final decision.
