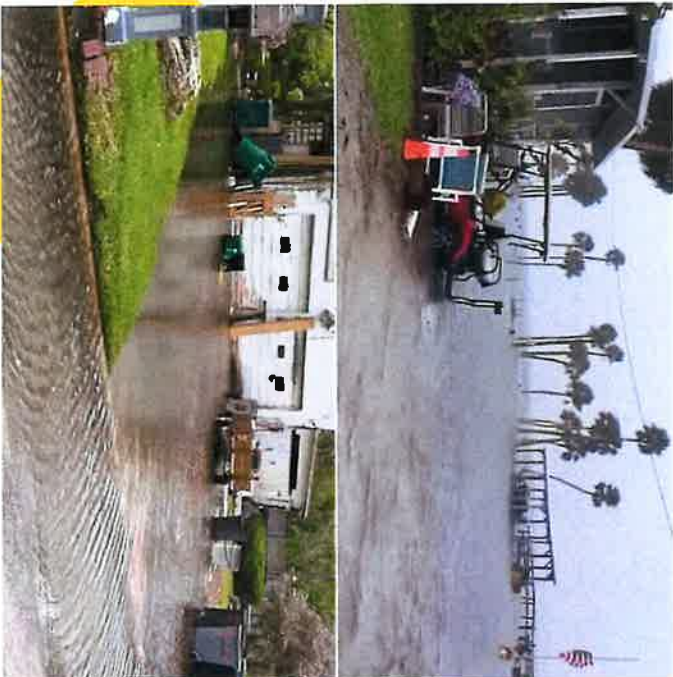
KING TIDES & RAIN: Views from Brevard County
