

- Maintained over 1,200 miles of roads, 600 miles of sidewalks, and 2,000 miles of ditches.
- Prepared budgets, capital improvements plans and production schedules for a \$20 million-a-year CIP program.
- Directed a department with average annual operating budget of close to \$37 million.

- Planned and produced designs and construction of improvements for roads throughout the community. Improvements included traffic signals at existing intersections, expanded signalization for improved intersections, construction of new road corridors and new sidewalks.
- Maintained over 350 signalized intersections and 75 school flashers.
- Managed various transportation-related programs, including traffic engineering, traffic operations, signing, striping, design, CIP construction, engineering, surveying, land acquisition and flood plain management with 65 employees.
