Requested Action:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners approve the following actions for the Trip and Equipment Grant from the Florida Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged in the amount of \$1,447,322:

- the Chair to sign the Authorizing Resolution,
- the Chair to sign the Grant Application,
- the Chair to sign the Standard Assurances,
- the Chair to execute the Grant Agreement, contingent upon County Attorney and Risk Management approval,
- the Interim Transit Director to execute any additional follow-up documentation, resolutions and amendments necessary to secure these funds,
- the County Manager to execute necessary Budget Change Requests.

Summary Explanation and Background:

This grant will enable Brevard County to provide curb-to-curb transportation services to residents who are Transportation Disadvantaged (TD) as defined in Florida Statute 427, Part 1. Funds in the Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund are allocated, on a formula basis, to each county according to the Florida Administrative Code 41-2. The formula is based on a comparative ranking of eligible recipients that includes the following categories: Transportation Disadvantaged eligible population of the county; total centerline miles of public roads in the county; Transportation Disadvantaged trips provided; and the state's total allocated funding from the previous year.

Brevard County has been allocated \$1,447,322 in State Fiscal Year 2021-2022 TD Trust Funds. The TD Trust Funds require a 10% local match.

Even though the TD Funds are distributed through a formula, once the agreement is signed, Space Coast Area Transit is reimbursed on a per passenger mile basis through a service rate developed by the CTD with the grant starting on July 1, 2021 to correspond with the State's Fiscal Year.

All of the funding will be used in providing curb-to-curb trips and not for the purchase of capital items. The funds are used to provide paratransit service throughout the county for Medical, Food Shopping, Employment, Educational and various trips, with Medical trips accounting for about ½ of the total service. A total of 38,033 trips were provided under this grant from April 2020 to March 2021. The grant funding is allocated and spent according to the State of Florida Fiscal Year; therefore the grant will begin on July 1, 2021. All of the funding is included in Transit Services FY2020-2021 operating budget and will be included in the FY 2021-2022 budget.

TRANSPORTATION DISADVANTAGED TRIP & EQUIPMENT GRANT STANDARD ASSURANCES

The Grantee hereby assures and certifies that:

- 1. The Grantee has the requisite fiscal, managerial, and legal capacity to carry out the Transportation Disadvantaged Program and to receive and disburse State funds.
- 2. The Grantee is aware that the Trip & Equipment Grant is a reimbursement grant. Reimbursement of funds will be approved for payment upon receipt of a properly completed invoice with supporting documentation.
- 3. Trip & Equipment Grant funds will not be used to supplant or replace existing federal, state, or local government funds.
- 4. The Grantee understands that an approved written eligibility application and eligibility support documentation is required and is to be maintained for each rider who receives a trip or bus pass funded by the Transportation Disadvantaged Trust Fund. Such documentation shall be made available upon request by CTD staff or its designee.
- 5. The Grantee is aware that if capital equipment is purchased with these grant funds, equipment must be received by the recipient no later than June 30, 2022.
- 6. The Grantee recipient is aware that the approved project must be complete by June 30, 2022, which means services must be provided by that date or reimbursement will not be approved.
- 7. Capital equipment purchased through this grant shall comply with the recipient's competitive procurement requirements or Chapter 287 or Chapter 427, Florida Statutes.
