Requested Action:

It is requested the Chair execute time extensions for three City of Melbourne Septic to Sewer contracts: SOIRL 18-04, SOIRL 18-61, and SOIRL 20-62

Summary Explanation and Background:

The Board of County Commissioners, in regular session on February 9, 2021, approved the 2021 Save Our Indian River Lagoon Plan Update plan, which included City of Melbourne septic to sewer conversion projects partially funded through the Save Our Indian River Lagoon Trust Fund.

The City of Melbourne has constructed the force main for each of these projects but has encountered homeowner participation delays. City staff are revising their ordinance to require connections for parcels in septic to sewer conversion projects. The City is seeking to amend their County reimbursement contracts to an expiration of December 31, 2023. The amendment for the Riverside Drive project, SOIRL 18-61, is attached. The other two amendments will use the same template if approved by the Board.

Per the Save Our Indian River Lagoon contract, time extensions for longer than six months must be approved by the Board.

AMENDMENT 2 TO THE SAVE OUR INDIAN RIVER LAGOON PROJECT COST-SHARE FUNDING INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA AND THE CITY OF MELBOURNE, FLORIDA

AGREEMENT NUMBER: SOIRL 18-61

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into by and between Brevard County, Florida, a political subdivision of the State of Florida (hereinafter "COUNTY"), and the City of Melbourne, Florida, a Florida municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Florida (hereinafter "CITY").

WHEREAS, the COUNTY approved this Project on April 10, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the parties previously entered into that certain Save Our Indian River Lagoon Project Cost-Share Funding Interlocal Agreement No. SOIRL 18-61 effective on February 12, 2019 ("Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into Amendment 1 to the Agreement on April 7, 2020, to adjust the contract expiration date from December 31, 2020, to August 31, 2021, and update the County Project Manager; and

WHEREAS, the parties are entering into this Amendment 2 in order to, among other things, correct dates and contract references in Amendment 1; and

WHEREAS, construction of the force main was completed but the CITY has experienced delays in homeowners connecting to the system; and

WHEREAS, the CITY is revising their septic ordinance to encourage homeowner participation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants herein contained, the parties hereby agree as follows:

1. The first WHEREAS clause in Amendment 1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

WHEREAS, the parties have previously entered into that certain Save Our Indian River Lagoon Project Cost-Share Funding Interlocal Agreement No. SOIRL 18-61 on February 12, 201917-05 ("ILA") on October 11, 2017; and

2. The date on page 3 of 4 of Amendment 1 is hereby amended to read as follows:

As aApproved by the Board on April 10, 2018 May 23, 2017

- 3. Section 3. Terms and Extensions subsection 3.a. is amended to read as follows:
 - a. The term of this Agreement is from the date upon which the last party has dated and executed the same ("Effective Date") until December 31, 2023

August 31, 2021 ("Completion Date"). CITY shall not commence the Project until any required submittals are received and approved. Time is of the essence for every aspect of this Agreement, including any time extensions.

4. The following sentences shall be added to the end of Section 14. Liability and Insurance of the Agreement as follows:

The parties' indemnity and liability obligations under this Agreement shall be limited to the extent of the protections of and limitations on damages as set forth in Section 768.28, Florida Statutes.

Nothing herein shall constitute a waiver of the parties' respective sovereign immunity.

- 5. Section 25. Local Preference Limitations is hereby deleted in its entirety, and shall be replaced with the new section identified below.
- 6. A new Section 25. Severability is hereby added to the Agreement as follows:

Section 25. Severability.

If any portion of this Agreement is found to be invalid or unenforceable or if applicable law mandates a different interpretation or result, the remaining provisions will remain in effect and the parties will negotiate in good faith to substitute for such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision a mutually acceptable provision consistent with the original intention of the parties.

- 7. The following provisions shall be added to the end of Section 29. Employment Eligibility Verification (E-Verify) of the Agreement as follows:
 - e. shall require any contractor to provide the City with an affidavit stating that it does not employ, contract with, or subcontract with any unauthorized aliens; and
 - f. Nothing in this Section may be construed to allow intentional discrimination of any class protected by law.
- 8. All terms and conditions of the Agreement, and any amendments thereto, not inconsistent with the provisions of this Second Amendment, are incorporated herein and shall remain in full force and effect.

Amendments Between Brevard County and the City of Melbourne

We respectfully request your signature on the attached Save Our Indian River Lagoon Project Cost-Share Funding Interlocal Agreement Amendments between Brevard County and the City of Melbourne for the Hoag, Riverside, and Roxy Septic to Sewer Projects. These projects were approved by the County Commission and included in the 2021 Update to the Save Our Indian River Lagoon Project Plan. The City of Melbourne requested a no-cost time extension amendment for a term of two years for each of these projects. This extension was approved by the Board of County Commissioners on May 27, 2021.

The construction of the force main has been completed and one property has been connected for each of the Hoag, Riverside, and Roxy Septic to Sewer Projects. The City has experienced delays in other homeowners connecting to the system and is revising their septic ordinance to encourage participation. These projects will reduce the amount of excess nutrients flowing to the Indian River Lagoon through the connection of properties from septic to sanitary sewer. The nutrient reduction benefit of this project is estimated to be 95, 305, and 102 pounds per year of total nitrogen and total phosphorus is to be determined, respectively. There is no change to the Save Our Indian River Lagoon Trust Fund costshare for these projects, which is \$86,031, \$262,044, and \$88,944, respectively.
