SUBJECT:

Interlocal Agreement with the City of Rockledge re: Transit Trash Cans and Cigarette Butt Containers

FISCAL IMPACT:

FY2018-2019: \$50,000, Fund 4136, Cost Center 363419, FTA 5307 Capital Funds

DEPT/OFFICE:

Transit Services

REQUESTED ACTION:

It is requested that the Board of County Commissioners approve and authorize the County Manager to sign an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Rockledge for the purpose of providing Transit Trash Cans and Cigarette Butt Containers within the City limits.

SUMMARY EXPLANATION and BACKGROUND:

The City of Rockledge has approached Space Coast Area Transit to provide Trash Cans and Cigarette Butt Containers at designated stops on official bus routes within the City. Space Coast Area Transit has funding for Transit Enhancement projects in its existing Federal Capital Grants of which bus stop amenities are an eligible expense. Each year, Space Coast Area Transit must allocate at least 1% of the Federal Fund Obligation to Transit Enhancements. Cleaning and upkeep of bus stop shelters and amenities is not an eligible Federal Capital project, therefore, Space Coast Area Transit is in the position to purchase and install these amenities and the City will clean and maintain them.

Space Coast Area Transit has similar agreements for Bus Shelters and Bus Benches with the Cities of Cape Canaveral, Cocoa Beach, Melbourne, Palm Bay, Titusville, West Melbourne and Eastern Florida State College (EFSC) creating partnerships in which Space Coast Area Transit purchases and pays for the shelter and bench installations and the City/College pays for the upkeep and non-capital repairs. Space Coast Area Transit has a current bus shelter agreement for bus shelters and benches, but not one for trash cans.

The Rockledge City Council approved the Agreement with the County at their March 20, 2019 Council Meeting.

**TRANSIT TRASH CANS & CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS
INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT**

This Interlocal Agreement is entered into this 21 day of MAY, 2019, by and between the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as the "County", and the CITY OF ROCKLEDGE, FLORIDA, a Florida Municipal Corporation, hereinafter referred to as the "City".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County has the authority to provide written authorization to a qualified entity for installing and maintaining TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS for the comfort and convenience to the general public, or at designated stops on official bus routes pursuant to Section 337.408, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the County desires to enter into an Agreement with the City to install and maintain TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS; and

WHEREAS, the City has secured property and locations for TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS for use within the City of Rockledge in compliance with rules set forth in Florida Administrative Code 14-20; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the covenants herein contained, it is mutually agreed between the parties as follows:

SECTION 1. PURCHASING AND LOCATION: As funding permits, the County hereby agrees to provide TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS at designated stops on official bus routes within the City. The modification, addition or removal of any agreed upon TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS location is permitted subject to written agreement of the County's Transit Director and the City Manager. Purchasing of these TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS by the County (Space Coast Area Transit) will be in accordance with Federal Grant and County purchasing guidelines.

SECTION 2. TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS DESIGN AND MAINTENANCE: The size, shape, and configuration and specific location of each and every TRASH CAN and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINER shall be subject to approval by the County and the City of Rockledge. The design of each TRASH CAN and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS will be based upon mutually agreed upon requirements and specifications identified by the County and City. Except as provided in Section 7 hereof, the City agrees to provide general cleaning, maintenance and trash removal for the TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS, including labor costs associated with repair of items located in or on the TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS. The

County agrees to provide repair parts and materials to the City for necessary repairs to or replacement of TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS.

SECTION 3. TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS INSTALLATION: The City agrees to provide the installation of the TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS and to comply with all applicable state, federal, and local laws, ordinances, rules and regulations in the construction, erection, installation and maintenance of the TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS, including without limitation, permitting. Installation is inclusive of all site planning, the pouring of concrete or pavement slabs for the purpose of providing a foundation for the TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS and construction of the TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS, in accordance with the vendor's installation specifications. The City will invoice the County (Space Coast Area Transit) for appropriate costs associated with these actions in accordance with price estimates established by the County in advance for each TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS location. Said price estimates are approximations of cost only and shall not provide binding amounts; provided, that in no event shall the total cost for installation sought to be reimbursed exceed by thirty percent (30%) the total estimated cost for installation. The County shall remit payment in accordance with the Florida Prompt Payment Act, Section 218.70, Florida Statutes, et seq.

SECTION 4. TERM AND USE: Each and every TRASH CAN and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINER installed and operated under this Agreement within the City shall be available to use by the general public on a gratis basis; provided, preclude the use of cans and containers by the general public during certain hours of the day, number of times per day, or when the cans or containers are in need of or under repair. The term of this Agreement is for a period of five (5) years, terminating on _____, 2024, unless otherwise extended.

SECTION 5. TERMINATION: Either party may terminate this Agreement for any reason upon at least sixty (60) days prior written notice. In the event of termination, the County (Space Coast Area Transit) will be responsible for the costs associated with the removal of the TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS. If deemed necessary by the City and agreed upon by both parties that the concrete pad or pavement must be removed, the costs associated with removal of the TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS concrete pad or pavement will be equally shared between the City and County. In the event the designated bus stop where the TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS is located is eliminated as part of the official bus route, or if the Department of Transportation mandates removal, the TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS, including the concrete pad and pavement, shall be removed by the County (Space Coast Area Transit), and any costs directly related to said removal shall be the responsibility of the County.

SECTION 6. SIGNAGE: Signs, messages, and advertising in any form shall be

prohibited on all TRASH CANS and CIGARETTE BUTT CONTAINERS, unless otherwise authorized by this Agreement or the City Code. However, even if otherwise authorized, said signs, messages, and advertising shall be approved by both the County Manager and City Manager.

SECTION 7. DAMAGE: The County agrees to repair, replace, and/or reimburse the City for any and all damages caused to property and equipment owned by the City resulting primarily from the action of County employees. The County shall cause such repair, replacement and/or reimbursement to occur within a reasonable amount of time thereby affording no undue hardship to the City.

The City agrees to repair, replace, and/or reimburse the County for any and all damages caused to property and equipment owned by the County resulting primarily from the action of City employees. The City shall cause such repair, replacement and/or reimbursement to occur within a reasonable amount of time thereby affording no undue hardship to the County.

SECTION 8. ATTORNEY'S FEES AND COSTS: In the event of any litigation between the parties arising out of this Agreement, each party will bear its own attorney's fees and costs.

SECTION 9. SEVERABILITY: If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word of this Agreement is, for any reason held by a Court to be unconstitutional, inoperative, or void, such holding shall not affect the remainder of this Agreement.

SECTION 10. HOLD HARMLESS/INDEMNIFICATION: The City, to the extent permitted by law, agrees to fully indemnify, defend, and hold the County, its officers, agents, and employees harmless against any claims for bodily injury, sickness, disease death or personal injury, or damage to property or loss of use resulting there from, including attorneys fees and court costs, arising out of this Agreement, or any services provided by the City pursuant to this Agreement, if such claims are as a result of the City's sole negligence.

The County, to the extent permitted by law, agrees to fully indemnify, defend, and hold the City, its officers, agents, and employees harmless against any claims for bodily resulting there from, including attorneys fees and court costs, arising out of this Agreement, or any services provided by the County pursuant to this Agreement, if such claims are as a result of the County's sole negligence.

In agreeing to this provision neither party intends to waive any defense or limited of sovereign immunity to which it may be entitled under Section 768.28, Florida Statutes or otherwise provided. The parties acknowledge specific consideration has been exchanged for this hold harmless/indemnification provision.

SECTION 11. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Agreement shall be effective upon signing

of both parties.

SECTION 12. JURISDICTION, VENUE, AND CHOICE OF LAW: All questions pertaining to the validity and interpretations of this Agreement shall be determined in accordance with the Laws of the State of Florida. Any legal action by either party against the other concerning the Agreement shall be filed in a court of competent jurisdiction in and for Brevard County, Florida, and any trial shall be non-jury.

SECTION 13. AUDITING, RECORDS AND INSPECTIONS: In the performance of this Agreement, the City and County shall keep books, records and account of all activities related to this Agreement, in compliance with generally accepted accounting procedures. Books, records, and accounts related to the performance of this Agreement shall be open to inspection during regular business hours by authorized representatives of both entities for a period of three (3) years after termination of this Agreement. All books, records, and accounts related to the performance of this Agreement shall be subject to the applicable provisions of the Florida Public Records Act, Chapter 119, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 14. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR: The City and County are independent contractors under this Agreement. Service provided by City pursuant to this Agreement shall be subject to the supervision of City and services provided by County pursuant to this Agreement shall be subject to the supervision of County. In providing such services, the City, its officers, employees, or agents are not authorized to and shall not act as officers, employees or agents of the County and the County, its officers, employees or agents are not authorized to and shall not act as officers, employees, or agents of the City. This Agreement shall not constitute or make the parties hereto a partnership or joint venture.

SECTION 15. E-VERIFY SYSTEM: The City shall utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system to verify the employment eligibility of all new employees hired by the City during the term of the contract; and shall expressly require any contractor or subcontractor performing work or providing services pursuant to the County Agreement to likewise utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system to verify the employment eligibility of all new employees hired by the subcontractor during the contract term. Contain in Attachment A is the *Confirmation of E-Verify Participation Form* to be executed.

SECTION 16. ASSIGNMENT: Neither this Agreement nor any interest herein shall be assigned, transferred, or encumbered by either party without the written consent of the other party.

SECTION 17. ENTIRE AGREEMENT: This Agreement, including any attachments attached hereto, sets forth the entire Agreement between the parties. This Agreement shall not be modified except in writing and executed by all parties. This Agreement was negotiated by both parties hereto. Consequently, no provision shall be more harshly interpreted against either party hereto as drafter of this Agreement.

CONFIRMATION OF E-VERIFY PARTICIPATION FORM

In accordance with BCC Policy 25 all vendors that conduct business with Brevard County are required to be registered with and utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify System in accordance with the terms governing use of the system.

1. The County shall not enter into, or renew, a contract for goods or services with a Vendor/contractor that is not enrolled into E-Verify. Any Vendor/contractor providing goods or services to the County shall be contractually required to utilize E-Verify to confirm the employment eligibility of any employee hired during the term of the contract.
2. Vendors/contractors shall provide acceptable evidence of their enrollment at the time of the submission of the vendor's/contractor's bid/quote/proposal. Acceptable evidence shall include, but not be limited to, a copy of the fully executed E-Verify Memorandum of Understanding for the business and/or a signed copy of this affidavit.

 - b. Where the requirement is waived by the Board of County Commissioners.
4. A vendor/contractor who registers with and participates in the E-Verify program may not be barred or penalized under BCC Policy 25(3)(V) if, as a result of receiving inaccurate verification information from the E-Verify program, the contractor hires or employs a person who is not eligible for employment.
5. Vendors/contractors shall expressly require any contractor or subcontractor performing work or providing services pursuant to the County contract to likewise utilize the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's E-Verify system to verify the employment eligibility of all new employees hired by the subcontractor during the contract term.
6. Nothing in BCC Policy 25(3)(V) may be construed to allow intentional discrimination of any class protected by law.
