Requested Action:
Direct staff to include in their interlocal agreement negotiations with CRAs, which the Board has authorized, the explicit authority to conduct internal audits, while noting that this shall have no effect on any authority the County currently holds.

Summary Explanation & Background:
The Board of County Commissioners, at the May 9th Commission meeting, directed the County Manager to move forward with interlocal agreement discussions with the Community Redevelopment Agencies.

This would direct staff to seek the authorization, to the extent it doesn't already exist, to conduct internal audits of CRAs. This would not limit any authority the County currently holds.
