SUMMARY EXPLANATION and BACKGROUND:



A special Port St. John Dependent Special District Board meeting will be held June 13, and the Board of County Commissioners will hear the request on July 10, 2018.






North Merritt Island Small Area Study

Storm Surge Map

The storm surge map (above) was created as part of the Statewide Regional Evacuation Study (SRES) Tide Atlas series published in 2010. This map identifies those areas subject to potential storm surge flooding from the five categories of hurricane on the Saffir Simpson Hurricane Wind Scale as determined by NOAA's numerical storm surge model, SLOSH. SLOSH stands for Sea, Lake and Overland Surges from Hurricane. The
