## RESOLUTION 19- 028

# A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING BREVARD COUNTY'S PREFERENCE OF MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION POLICY OF MATHERS BRIDGE.

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2017, the Brevard County Public Works Department, requested the United States Coast Guard to consider allowing Mathers Bridge to not open for vessels except every 30 minutes on the hour and half hour; and

WHEREAS, the county requested this action in order to reduce traffic delays caused by the numerous openings of the bridge and to reduce "wear and tear" on the bridge operating mechanism; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest of Brevard County taxpayers to reduce the high cost associated with the proper maintenance of this critical piece of infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS,** on April 24, 2017, the Coast Guard published a notice of proposed rule-making (NPRM) entitled Drawbridge Operation Regulation; Banana River, Indian Harbour Beach, FL in the Federal Register (82 FR 18877) and received minimal comments; and

**WHEREAS,** the City of Indian Harbour Beach, FL requested to have the comment period re-opened as they believed their constituency did not have awareness of the initial notice and comment period; and

WHEREAS, on October 23, 2017, a notice of proposed rule-making was published; reopening comment period entitled Drawbridge Operation Regulation; Banana River, Indian Harbour Beach, FL in the Federal Register (82 FR 48939); and

WHEREAS, due to the numerous comments received both for and against the proposed rule, the Coast Guard published a temporary deviation to test the proposed schedule change to determine whether a permanent change is appropriate to better balance the needs of maritime and vehicle traffic; and

**WHEREAS**, the Coast Guard conducted a test deviation, from 6 a.m. on February 5, 2018 to 6 a.m. on August 4, 2018, the bridge was open for vessels requesting passage on the hour and half hour, from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m., Sunday through Thursday. On Friday, Saturday and all Federal holidays, 24 hours a day, the bridge was open for vessels on the hour and half hour. At all other times, the bridge was open on signal if at least two hours notice was given. The bridge was able to open for emergencies; and

**WHEREAS**, this body of water is not tidal, is relatively shelter, is not adversely affected by wind, and is not shallow or shoaled, therefore a maritime safety is not an issue; and

WHEREAS, the Coast Guard will soon make a determination on the permanent opening schedule of Mathers bridge.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF BREVARD COUNTY FLORIDA, that the board supports and encourages the Coast Guard to approve the permanent opening schedule of every 30 minutes on the hour and half hour. This schedule will provide a more predictive and cost effective operation, reducing traffic backup, provide a more predictable, and a safer transportation environment.
