TIME . LIGHT . SPACE

- 1848** First lighthouse built on Cape - 65' tall brick tower
- 1853** 1886 Mills O. Burnham - longest serving Head Keeper
- 1868** New 151' tall iron lighthouse built - delayed by Civil War
- 1894** Iron lighthouse moved inland, brick lighthouse razed
- 1931** Iron Lighthouse electrified
- 1950** Cape enters the space age with first launch - Bumper 8
- 1960** Lighthouse automated - last Keepers leave
- 1993** Fresnel lens replaced due to rocket vibration damage
- 2000** Air Force assumes ownership of lighthouse
US Coast Guard continues to tend light
- 2002** Lighthouse Foundation formed
- 2019** Head Keeper's replica cottage built housing
the lighthouse museum and gift shop
- 2020** Air Force transfers ownership to the Space Force
- 2025 - 2026** Two replica Keeper's cottages to be built

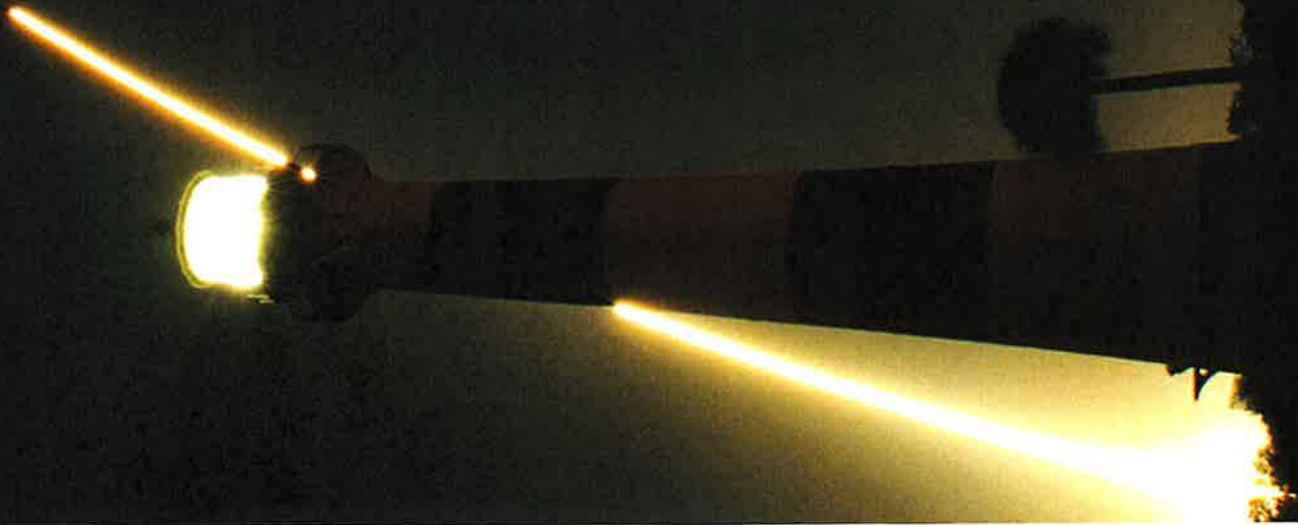
Start your exploration of the history of Cape Canaveral Florida and its link to America's space program at the Cape Canaveral Lighthouse.

CAPE CANAVERAL LIGHTHOUSE: AND SPACE FORCE STATION TOURS

Our amazing 151 foot tall lighthouse is still actively protecting our mariners and coast after 155 years. Over the years, it has evolved from oil lamp, to automation, to electricity and still continues to serve. Since it sits on the Cape Canaveral Space Force Station (CCSFS) property, the public is not allowed to drive on site without an escort, therefore all visits must be booked via our website, several days in advance.

We offer tours for individuals, adult and children's groups of 10 or more, and educational tours for all school aged students. All tours take two to four hours, depending on the tour you select and we offer them several days per week.

Open House for CCSFS badged personnel occurs every Wednesday from 10 am - 1 pm. Hangar C will also be open during these hours.

Once here, you'll get to explore our historical lighthouse and grounds, Keepers Cottage Museum and Gift Shop! Adjacent to the lighthouse grounds, visit Hangar C, where you'll see restored launch systems and rockets on display, some of which can only be seen here. Lastly, you'll get to tour the Cape Canaveral Space Force Museum!

EDUCATIONAL GROUP TOURS

These tours are FREE and designed for public, private, charter or homeschooled students. Tour lasts approximately 90 minutes depending on the size of your group - must be 48" tall to climb the lighthouse. Any adult can book these for a group of at least 10 students. Tour curriculum is designed to meet 4th grade Sunshine State Standards, and integrates the relevant concepts of STEM disciplines, however, the tour is appropriate for any age group. Your visit will include the Lighthouse, Keeper's Cottage Museum, Hangar C and an additional CCSFM at Launch Complex 26, if time permits.

- Available days are Tuesdays, Wednesdays or Thursdays.
- Your educational group will be escorted by our volunteers and docents during your tour.
- Your group is responsible for providing their own transportation for the tour.
