**IN RE: JUDGES – CASELOAD REASSIGNMENT – CLERK OF COURT PROCEDURE FOR  
REASSIGNMENT OF CASES IN SEMINOLE COUNTY**

Whereas, pursuant to the case of *Sume v. State*, 773 So.2d 600 (Fla. 1<sup>st</sup> DCA 2000), it is,

**ORDERED** that any administrative order directing the Clerk of Court to not assign initially filed complaints or petitions and/or reassign any pending cases in which a named attorney or firm can no longer appear before a specific judge must contain the individual name(s) of the attorney(s) as well as the respective Florida Bar number(s).

This does not apply to:

1. Orders of Reassignment in which the Administrative Judge or a specific judge within a particular division orders the transfer of a case to a particular judge.
2. Any pending case where an attorney files a Notice of Appearance in a specific case with a known recusal order in effect.
